## God Speaks To Us Through His Word

### LORD'S DAY 25 - Heidelberg Catechism Questions

65. Since then we are made partakers of Christ and all his benefits by faith only, whence comes this faith?

A. From the Holy Spirit, who works faith in our hearts, by the preaching of the gospel, and confirms it by the use of the sacraments.

66. What are the Sacraments?

A. The sacraments are holy, visible signs and seals, appointed of God for this purpose, that by their use, He may more fully declare and seal to us the promise of the gospel, that he grants us freely the remission of sin, and life eternal for the sake of that one sacrifice of Christ, accomplished on the cross.

67. Are both these, then, the Word and the Sacraments, designed to direct our faith to the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross, as the only ground of our salvation?

A. Yes, indeed: for the Holy Spirit teaches us in the gospel, and assures us by the sacraments, that the whole of our salvation depends on that one sacrifice of Christ which he offered for us on the cross.

68. How many Sacraments has Christ appointed in the New Testament?

A. Two: namely, holy baptism, and the holy supper.
