LORD'S DAY 41 - Heidelberg Catechism Questions

108. What does the seventh commandment teach us?

A. That all uncleanness is accursed of God, and that therefore we must with all our hearts detest the same, and live chastely and temperately, whether in holy wedlock, or in single life.

109. Does God in this commandment forbid nothing more than adultery and such like gross sins?

A. Since both our body and soul are temples of the Holy Spirit, he commands us to preserve them pure and holy. Therefore, He forbids all unchaste actions, gestures, words, thoughts, desires, and whatever can entice men to this sin.
