*LORD'S DAY 9 - Heidelberg Catechism Questions - OF GOD THE FATHER*

26. *What do you believe when you say, "I believe in God the Father, Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth?"*

**A. That the eternal Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (who of nothing made heaven and earth, with all that is in them; who likewise upholds and governs the same, by His eternal counsel and providence) is for the sake of Christ His Son, my God and my Father; on whom I rely so entirely, that I have no doubt but that He will provide me, with all things necessary for soul and body: and further, that He will make whatever evils He sends upon me, in this valley of tears, turn out to my advantage; for He is able to do it, being Almighty God, and willing, being a faithful Father.**


